



## HOLIDAY LIPBALM HOLDER

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Penguin Place (156410)

Punch: Penguin Builder (156452)

BUNDLE: Penguin Place Bundle (156789)

Dies: Cabin Dies (156404), Layering Circle Dies (151770)

Specialty Paper: Sweet Stockings DSP (156281), Snowy White Velvet (156405)

Cardstocks: Basic Black (121045), Basic White (159276), Real Red (102482), Mossy Meadow (133676)

Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Real Red (147084), Soft Suede (147115), Pool Party (147107), Pumpkin Pie (147086), Mossy Meadow (147111)

Twine & Embellishments: Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475), Wonderful Snowflakes (156340), Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Subtle Shimmer Sequins (156407)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal+ (149699), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300)

Outer piece - cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 3/4" x 3 1/2" – place into scoring tool with a long edge at the top and score down at 2 1/2" and 3 1/4" – fold along the score lines using a bone folder



Inner piece – cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 3/8" x 3 1/4" – place into scoring tool with a long edge at the top and score down at 2 1/4" and 3"



Measure 1 3/8" down from the top edge and make a pencil mark on the first score line – then measure 1 3/8" up from the bottom edge and do the same



Then from that pencil mark, measure 1 3/8" across and draw a line



Repeat from the top pencil mark and draw a line – add a vertical line to join them for a guide



Use a craft knife on a self healing mat to cut along the top and bottom lines



When done, use an eraser to get rid of the pencil lines



Fold along the score lines and use strong adhesive tape to adhere the inner piece inside the outer piece making sure NOT to add tape to that center piece you just cut out – that bit needs to be able to move freely and is where you will pop your lipbalm

**This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:**







If your lipbalm moves around, simply add a Mini Glue Dot to the back of it to hold it in place...
