



## No Sew Gnome

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Cardstock: Petal Pink
- Accessories: Jolly Felt, Baker's Twine Essentials Pack, Round & Square Brads, I Clear Acrylic Block, Mini Jam Jar
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Paper Snips, Take Your Pick Tool, Hippo & Friends Dies, So Many Snowflakes Dies, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
- Miscellaneous: Tear & Tape, Mini Glue Dots

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Cut 6" x 6" piece of Old Olive Jolly Felt using the Paper Trimmer.

2. Fold felt to make a triangle making sure it will slip onto a Mini Jam Jar. Tie a double strand of White Baker's Twine into a bow around the top of the hat to keep it together. Using the Take Your Pick tool, poke a hole into top two layers of felt.



3. Trim the back of the gnome hat with Paper Snips.



4. Cut snowflake from White Jolly Felt with the So Snowflakes Dies and attach Square White Brad in the middle. Attach it to the gnome hat by putting the brad through the hole in the Old Olive Felt.



5. Wrap the entire spool of White Baker's Twine around the I Acrylic Block, leaving a tail at the end. Use a needle to slip the tail under all of the twine and wrap around the twine twice then tie a knot to hold it together.



6. Attach a piece of Tear & Tape to the inside front of the Gnome hat. Add the Baker's Twine and hold it in place by adding another piece of Tear & Tape over the top. Do not remove the cover of the tape. Cut the loops of the Baker's Twine at the bottom of the beard.



7. Using the balloon die from the Hippo & Friends Dies cut a gnome nose from Petal Pink cardstock and adhere it with a Mini Glue Dot. Fill your Mini Jam Jar with candy or other small gift.



8. Finish by slipping the gnome hat onto the Mini Jam Jar.
